Jura Grey limestone is quarried from a bedrock quarry in Eichstatt, Germany. It happens to be very dense, making it suitable for both commercial and residential applications. One of the unique characteristics of this limestone is the existence of large shells and fossils that may appear throughout the tile or slabs. Another quality of this material are the quartz veins that can appear throughout the material. These veins are a natural characteristic of the material and are expected to be visible in some pieces of the product. This is a sedimentary stone that is formed in shallow seas and is composed mainly of calcite calcium carbonate. There will be noticeable variations in color and movement between pieces, ranging in color from light grey to dark grey and a mix of beige. Therefore, it is important and recommended that a range of this product be viewed before finalizing a purchase. Due to the qualities of the stone, the slabs are book-matched; meaning slab one and slab two will be cut and polished to create a mirror image of each other. As with any limestone being used for kitchen tops it's possible to scratch, etch or stain this material so a trivet or cutting board should always be used. It is also important to keep Jura Grey sealed so regular applications of sealer is required when using on a kitchen top. As a natural stone product, it is recommended that it be sealed to extend its longevity.
