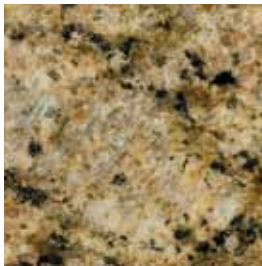

Giallo Veneziano is quarried in a bedrock quarry that is found in the Northern region of the state of Espirito Santo, Brazil, near the small town of Nova Venezia, from which the granite takes its name. Currently, this quarry is one of the largest in existence in Brazil. This color produces more than three hundred truckloads of granite per month. Current research shows the quarry contains five hundred years' worth of Giallo Veneziano available, to quarry, at present rate of production. During the polishing process, an epoxy resin is applied to the surface of the stone to fill in any natural pits, cracks or fissures that may exist. This does not affect the durability, maintenance or beauty of the stone. It is possible for some of the more minute pits that are too small to effectively hold the resin, to reopen during other finishing stages. However, this will not detract from the overall quality or appearance of the stone. As a natural stone product it is recommended that it be sealed to extend its longevity.



NSF indicates this product conforms to the requirements of NSF/ANSI Standard 51, thereby meeting the health and sanitation requirements for materials used in areas of food preparation.
