Imperial Brown is also cross-referenced as Imperial Coffee, and is quarried from large boulders in the state of Espirito Santo, Brazil. The rice grain structure of this granite will change into a more oval or even rounded look as blocks are quarried closer to the center of the boulder. It is also characteristic for the coffee color to vary between boulders. During the polishing process, an epoxy resin is applied to the surface of the stone to fill in any natural pits, cracks or fissures that may exist. This does not affect the durability, maintenance or beauty of the stone. It is possible for some of the more minute pits that are too small to effectively hold the resin, to reopen during other finishing stages. However, this will not detract from the overall quality or appearance of the stone. As a natural stone product it is recommended that it be sealed to extend its longevity.
