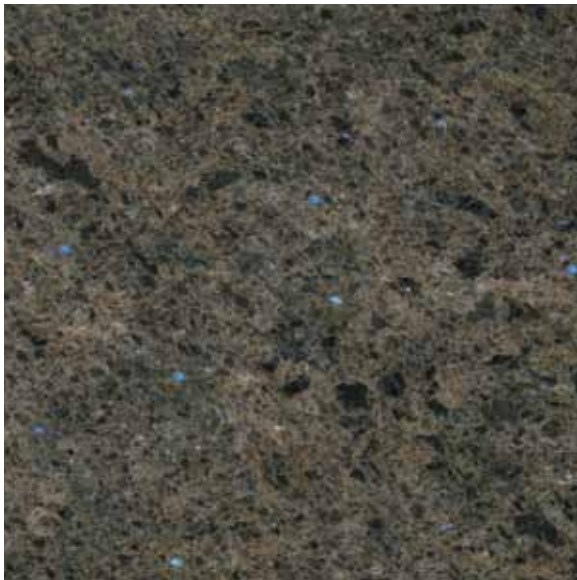

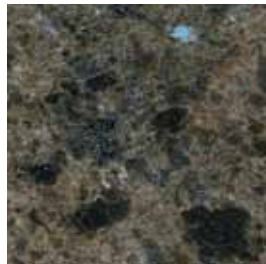

Labrador Antique is quarried from a bedrock quarry in Egersond, Norway. It is formed only of coarse-grain crystals with a variable intensity of brown color. Another unique characteristic of this stone is the crystals that show a blue metallic mica reflection (iridescence), which will form spots on the brown background. Due to the qualities of the stone, the slabs are book-matched; meaning slab one and slab two will be cut and polished to create a mirror image of each other. These are then kept in sequence, which allows for a consistent flow in pattern. During the polishing process, an epoxy resin is applied to the surface of the stone to fill in any natural pits, cracks or fissures that may exist. This does not affect the durability, maintenance or beauty of the stone. It is possible for some of the more minute pits that are too small to effectively hold the resin, to reopen during other finishing stages. However, this will not detract from the overall quality or appearance of the stone. Finally, a mesh backing is adhered to the stone. As a natural stone product it is recommended that it be sealed to extend its longevity.



NSF indicates this product conforms to the requirements of NSF/ANSI Standard 51, thereby meeting the health and sanitation requirements for materials used in areas of food preparation.
