Camargo is quarried from a bedrock quarry in Chihuahua, Mexico. This is a sedimentary stone that is formed in shallow seas and is composed mainly of calcite calcium carbonate. Over millions of years, water has penetrated deep into the stone through small cracks and fissures, causing the iron oxide and other minerals to oxidize. It is this process that produces the slight rust veining that can be visible throughout this limestone. Prior to honing, this limestone is filled with a colored cement to fill in any natural cavities, or pits. Due to varying climate conditions, the color of the fill can vary between shipments. There will be noticeable variations in color and movement between pieces. Therefore, it is important and recommended that a range of this product be viewed before finalizing a purchase. Arizona Tile also offers Camargo as a product in our tumbled program, which will include a multitude of mosaics and tile sizes that will provide a more unique style to any design. As a natural stone product it is recommended that it be sealed to extend its longevity.
