Chapala Vein Cut is quarried from a bedrock quarry in Mexico. This travertine is produced for Arizona Tile utilizing the full range of production. This means that everything being produced from the block is packed in the crate. Due to this process, there will be noticeable variations in color and movement between pieces, including color range and fill hole size; therefore, it is important and recommended that a range of this product be viewed before finalizing a purchase. In order to achieve this linear look, the stone blocks are cut vertically, which is the traditional way of producing travertine. All travertine stones will have natural cavities, or pits, visible in the stone that were developed when carbon dioxide bubbles became trapped during the formation of the stone. Prior to honing, this travertine is filled with a colored cement to fill in these cavities, and due to varying climate conditions, the color of the fill can differ between shipments. Piece to piece variation in shade or color are inherent in all natural stone products; therefore, when installing natural stone tile, it is recommended to mix tiles from several boxes at a time during installation to achieve the best range of color. As natural stone products, it is recommended that these be sealed to extend their longevity. As a natural stone product it is recommended that it be sealed to extend its longevity.
