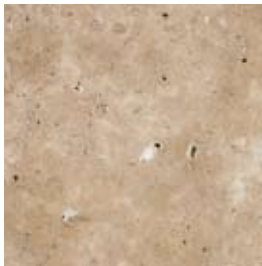

Mexican Noce is quarried near Torreon, Mexico. This is a sedimentary stone that is formed in hot springs and is composed of calcite calcium carbonate. All travertine stones will have natural cavities, or pits visible in the stone that developed when carbon dioxide bubbles became trapped during the formation of the stone. As an unfilled travertine, the pits will remain visible and unfilled until they are filled with grout during installation. Overall, this will provide a more natural aesthetic to the installation of this stone. Arizona Tile also offers unfilled Mexican Noce as a product of our tumbled program, which will offer a multitude of mosaics and tile sizes that will provide a more rustic style to any design.

However, the slabs for this travertine are produced filled, unlike the tile that are unfilled. There can be noticeable variances between tile and slabs, so it is important and recommended that a range of this product be viewed before finalizing a purchase.
