Commercial Residential Countertops Interior Wall Fireplaces Shower Walls Meteor Shower Satin is quarried from a bedrock quarry in Minas Gerais, Brazil. The blocks are cut to show a three dimensional look which is unique and different from any granite in the market. The slabs are brushed, which give them the satin finish and adds to the 3-D look. Due to the qualities of the stone, the slabs are book-matched; meaning slab one and slab two will be cut and brushed to create a mirror image of each other. These are then kept in sequence, which allows for a consistent flow in pattern. As a natural stone product, it is recommended that it be sealed to extend its longevity.

Meteor Shower Satin has an epoxy sealer applied to the surface of the slab during processing, which darkens the color of the slab. To achieve the same dark look on the edge detail, the fabricator will need to apply Tenax Ager Tiger.
